ETREYS & Youth Tour Guidelines

ATTENTION: Sophomores and Juniors – Please fill out the forms completely. This is the information that will be used in determining the winners for the East Texas Rural Electric Youth Seminar (ETREYS) seminar and the Government-in-Action Youth Tour. **The deadline for the return of these forms is February 9, 2018.**

PURPOSE: The purpose of ETREYS is to enhance leadership and problem-solving skills in a positive learning environment on a college campus. ETREYS was also developed to promote the cooperative philosophy, ideals and values among young people and to build loyalty for the program.

PROGRAM: The program consists of a weeklong curriculum, including workshops, seminars and peer group activities. You'll meet outstanding speakers from all over the United States. Several social functions and free-time activities will also be held to provide an opportunity for developing friendships and meeting new people. You'll be joining about 125 students from other East Texas high schools.

DATES: ETREYS is scheduled for **Monday, June 25 through June 29, 2018.**
Government-in-Action Youth Tour is scheduled for **Wednesday, June 6 through Friday, June 15, 2018.**

LOCATION: ETREYS is currently planned to be held on the campus of East Texas Baptist University in Marshall, Texas. All activities for the week will be coordinated by the school at various locations throughout the campus. Government-in-Action Youth Tour is held in Austin, Texas and Washington D.C.

HOUSING: This program is designed around living on campus in student dormitories. **Women will stay in Maybee Hall and men will stay in Fry Hall.** We will be the only group staying in the dorm at the time of the seminar. **Chaperones will also be housed in the dorms.** ETBU will provide student assistants for camp week.

SCHOLARSHIPS: All participants in ETREYS will be eligible for **one of nine \$500 scholarships and four additional scholarships up to \$1,000.** Students will compete based on their completed application, personal interview with judges, multiple choice test, and observation of their attitude, cooperation and overall involvement in planned activities by chaperones.

COST: Your participation in either of these programs is totally funded by Jasper-Newton Electric Cooperative, Inc. (JNEC). Transportation to and from ETREYS will be provided from JNEC.

YOUTH TOUR: Jasper-Newton Electric Cooperative, Inc. (JNEC) will sponsor two area high school students on the 54th Government-in-Action Youth Tour 2018 to Washington DC. The all-expense-paid Youth Tour will be held June 6th – 15th in Washington, D.C. The Youth Tour focuses on educating youth on rural electrification to better their understanding of electric cooperatives. The tour provides the students with an opportunity to visit the Capitol, historical sites and museums. They also will have an opportunity to meet with their congressional representative to better understand how their federal government works. Cindy Montgomery of JNEC is serving as Youth Tour coordinator this year.
